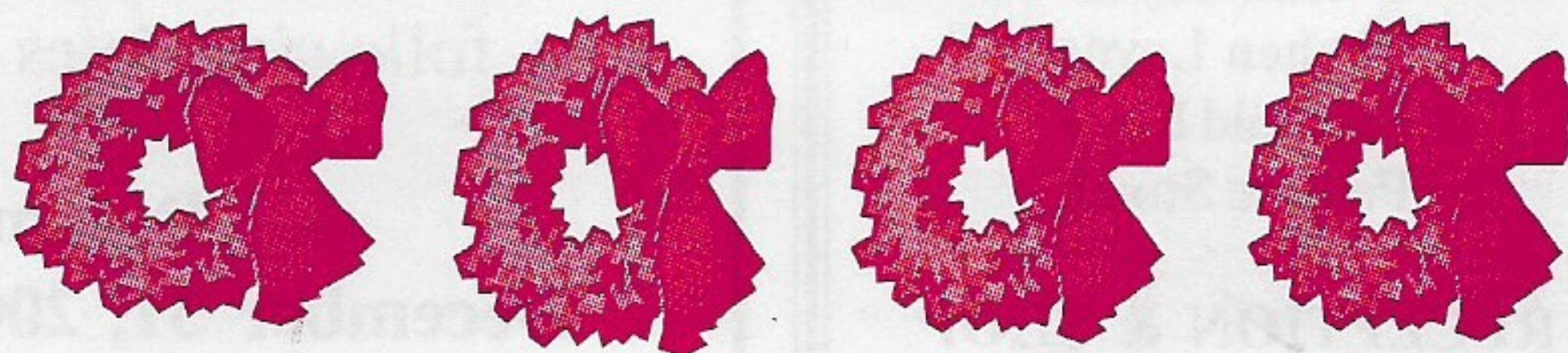
### *Research tool*
